Dear Dr. Meehan:

The Foundation for the Accreditation of Cellular Therapy (FACT) is pleased to award accreditation under the FACT-JACIE International Standards for Hematopoietic Cellular Therapy to DHMC Transplant and Cellular Therapy Program in Lebanon, New Hampshire. The accreditation for your organization is effective for three years beginning March 30, 2026. This accreditation applies to all services and facilities that were inspected by FACT, specifically:

- Adult allogeneic and autologous hematopoietic progenitor cell transplantation
• Immune effector cellular therapy
• Cellular therapy product collection by apheresis for administration and further manufacturing
• Cellular therapy product processing with minimal manipulation

This letter and the corresponding Response Report are confidential. If you choose to share these documents with other parties (e.g., commercial companies manufacturing cellular therapy products), you should implement an agreement with the other party that specifies the intention of use and maintenance of confidentiality.

Please notify the FACT Accreditation Office if there are significant personnel, service, facility location, or contractual changes in your organization. Any new services provided by your organization within the accreditation cycle must be implemented in compliance with the FACT Standards and reported to FACT. If you use contracted services in your organization, you are responsible for monitoring the accreditation status of those contracted service providers and for notifying FACT of any change in providers.

FACT accredited organizations are required to complete an annual report one year after achieving accreditation. You will receive an annual report notification 30 days before the report is due. Your organization's annual FACT accreditation fees will be invoiced at that time and with the renewal application. Renewal accreditation is required every three years to maintain accredited status.

Accredited organizations are listed on the FACT website at https://accredited.factglobal.org/. FACT encourages your program to publicize its accreditation to patients, providers, insurance

carriers, and other community stakeholders. In your advertisement, you must accurately represent your FACT accreditation by specifying the accredited areas and services detailed above. We expect that you will refrain from linking this accreditation to unsubstantiated medical claims.

A media press kit is available in the FACT Accreditation Portal to assist your program in communicating your accreditation. This includes a list of publicity strategies, a sample press release, and an electronic copy of the FACT Seal of Accreditation.


To access the media press kit and the Seal of Accreditation, your Organization Director or Co-Director must first complete and sign the FACT Seal of Accreditation License Agreement available through the left navigation pane in the Portal. The materials will then be available to the Organization Director, Organization Co-Director, Facility Directors, Quality Managers, and the primary contact.

We encourage personnel at your organization to become FACT inspectors. Personnel who serve as FACT inspectors enjoy many benefits, including free access to FACT educational sessions, awareness of how other organizations comply with accreditation requirements, and increased exposure to the cellular therapy community. Organizations with inspectors have more impact on the development of standards and accreditation requirements.
