- Nurses on units who do not do lab draws:
 - o Routine Labs: Inpatient phlebotomy will continue to support.
 - Urgent/Stat Labs: Seek support from Unit staff trained for phlebotomy, Life Safety (35-5310) or VAS (35-9260).
 - Prior to paging Life Safety or VAS, please:
 - Release the orders and place the Lab Requisition in the Unit's Phlebotomy Bin or VAS Bin, as appropriate.
